> Projects:

In 5-9-2018, Beit Jala Municipality presented by its mayor Mr. Nicola Khamis and Mrs. Samia Zeit, the director of the Engineering Department in the Municipality and Mr. Walid Khateeb, the financial manager of the municipality signed a memorandum of understanding for building up "Ruwad Center" with Bethlehem University/ Institute for Community Partnership presented by its Vice Chancellor Br. Peter Bray and Vice President for Finance, Mr. Youil Anastas and the Director of the Institute for Community Partnership, Mr. Mousa Rabadi. The main aim of this project is to develop and reinforce the entrepreneur and creative initiatives for youth in Beit Jala city.





Beit Jala Municipality represented by its mayor Mr. Nicola Khamis, , signed a memorandum of understanding in the Municipality of Beit Jala on Wednesday 26-9-2018 for the project "Food Security and Livelihoods on the Use of Environmental Farming Systems and Conservation of Water Resources in Al-Makhrur / Beit Jala" represented by its Director General Sister Brigitte Tai And partner institutions The St.-Yves Foundation is represented by its Director-General, Mr. Rafol Roufa, and the Bethlehem Farmers' Association, represented by its President Mr. Ibrahim Manasra and the Beit Jala Farmers Association, represented by its President, Mr. Bashir Alsous. The agreement provides for the role of each partner institution and the necessity of enhancing cooperation between them to implement the project "Food Security and Livelihoods on the Use of Environmental Farming Systems and Conservation of Water Resources in Al-Maharur / Beit Jala", which includes the use of environmental farming methods Agricultural irrigation networks on an estimated area of 18 dunums.

It is worth mentioning that this project is the first of its kind at the governorate level and the largest at the national level. This project is in line with the strategy of the Palestinian Ministry of Agriculture and partner institutions. The project is being implemented with the support of Zaragoza Municipality in Spain and Caritas Spain. The agreement has already been signed with partner institutions, including an explanation of the expected results of this project.

Sister Brigitte Tay stressed the necessity of implementing this project during 2018-2019 because it is important to the residents of Beit Jala, which is part of a series of projects carried out in the same area.





❖ German- Palestinian Cultural days
